





USGA Rules and the following local rule will govern all play:

- Out of bounds is defined by white stakes and by inside edges of public streets (Rule 27).
- Red stakes/lines define lateral water hazards (Rule 26-1).
- Yellow stakes/lines define regular water hazards (Rule 26-1).
- The embedded ball rule is in effect "through the green."
- All paved roads with the exception of cart paths are out of bounds.
- Yardage indicators, sprinkler control boxes, rain shelters, obstructions (Rule 24-2).
- Ground under repair The following mulched areas are considered ground under repair. All other areas are considered part of the course and no relief is granted.
  - Right side of #1.
  - Left of #3.
  - Pampas grass at #4 tee.
  - Flower bed at #13.

## Please:

- CARTS ARE RESTRICTED TO THE PATHS AROUND ALL TEES AND GREEN WITHOUT EXCEPTION.
- Observe the 90 degree rule for cart traffic.
